

How to Pack Film

Sheet Film

Sheet film should be sleeved then placed in an empty film box. The box should be sealed with tape and placed in a plastic bag (Ziplock works well). Wrap the box with bubble wrap then place it in a sturdy box for shipping. Be certain the film box is sufficiently padded so as not to slide around inside the shipping box. Use packing tape (not Scotch or masking tape) to seal the shipping box.

Roll Film

Roll film should be sleeved and cut to the specified frame(s) to be scanned. PrintFile makes a number of products well suited for 35mm and 120/220 roll film. Sandwich the PrintFile page(s) between heavy/corrugated boards. Tape around the sides so the PrintFile page(s) cannot slide out from the boards. Place the "sandwich" in a sealable plastic bag. Wrap the plastic bag with bubble wrap and place it in a sturdy box for shipping. Be certain there is sufficient padding around the "sandwich" so as not to slide around inside the shipping box. Use packing tape (not Scotch or masking tape) to seal the shipping box.
